Assignment: This assignment should be no more than one typed page. ***Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why or why not?***

Your page should include a heading (BMS writing standards), must be double spaced in 12 point font, should be well organized and your ideas should be detailed and fully developed. Edit for spelling and grammar.

Remember, your writing must have at least one direct quote from the novel cited properly (MLA). Quotes should be used as evidence to support your reason(s) and should be analyzed.
