



2020-2021 Grade Seven Supply List

Students in Grade Seven will be asked to keep their supplies and materials with them through the morning and then again in the afternoon. Students will have two separate binders (AM and PM) and Advisors and other teachers will work to help students learn how to organize and update their binders routinely as part of class lessons.

Binders, Folders Paper and Related Materials

- **Two, 2 Inch Reinforced Binders from Staples.**

We have watched how students use binders carefully for years now and highly recommend you purchase the **Staples Better 2-Inch D 3-Ring View Binder**. It is the most durable binder we have seen. The color does not matter, but students will need two of them (one for the morning and one for the afternoon) so two different colors might be helpful. - Loose leaf paper (wide ruled- not college ruled) Keep a supply at home, too.
- 100 pack of 3 hole plastic sheet protectors (used in multiple classes)
- 1 pack of colored plastic TAB reinforced 3 hole binder subject dividers
- 2 100 sheet composition notebooks for English class (Writer and Reader notebooks)
- 4 two-pocket paper folders
- 2 100 sheet composition notebook for Spanish

Pencils, Pens and Other Materials

- A pencil case **with your name written in Sharpie on the outside and inside.**

You choose. Some people like the type that fit in the rings of a binder, others prefer different styles.

- Pencils (#2 Ticonderoga are best)
- Several ballpoint pens (blue or black) Please, no “clicking” pens-- teachers don’t like these.
- Several red ballpoint pens
- A small pack of colored pencils (sharpened)
- 1 Highlighter
- 6 inch ruler (should have cm and in.)
- Several packs of 100 3x5 index cards (keep most at home)

- 1 One subject spiral bound notebook for Health class
