RE: Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test and National Merit Scholarship

Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT)

On Wednesday, **October 16, 2019,** Bronxville High School will be administering the PSAT/NMSQT at **8:00a.m.** Testing should conclude by noon. This preliminary exam is intended for third year high school students, to predict a range within which their SAT scores may fall, and to afford them consideration for National Merit Scholarships. Students will have the opportunity to better prepare for the SAT using diagnostic information available with their score reports. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the exam, please speak with your counselor.

The fee for the PSAT is \$17. Registration for the PSAT/NMSQT is completed by Bronxville High School, so please bring checks to the Counseling Office in a sealed envelope with your name, grade and "PSAT" written on the front of the envelope by Monday, October 7, 2019. Your payment of the fee is your admission ticket to the exam. The <u>Student Guide to the PSAT/NMSQT</u>, a detailed description/sample of the test, will be distributed to all who register.

On the day of the exam, **students should report to the High School (Meadow Avenue entrance) by 7:45a.m.** Extended Time Students will be assigned a separate location. For additional information regarding the exam, please visit the College Board website at www.collegeboard.org.
